We want to thank you for considering a contact lens fitting with Dr. Bussey and Dr. Stevens. It is important to understand what is involved with a contact lens fitting. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to ask.

Contact Lens Evaluation

All patients wearing contact lenses will undergo a contact lens evaluation for fit, comfort, prescription power and corneal health at your annual exam.

- This revalidates your prescription for one year.
- Your contact lenses have been evaluated and your current lenses are optimal.
- Contact lens evaluation will be a charge of \$55

Contact Lens Fitting

Any new patient to our office, new brand of contact lens, or new contact lens wearer will be examined and counselled as to an optimal type, Rx, and brand of contact lenses for each individual's needs.

Below are the categories of fitting fees. Your fees will be determined by the physician. Fees are due at the time of the fitting and are non-refundable. If you decide to upgrade to a different category (i.e. sphere or bifocals) after the initial visit, additional fees will be added. Fees do not include the price of the contact lenses.

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| A. Soft sphere lenses | \$90.00 |
| B. Toric lenses | \$105.00 |
| C. Monovision or multifocal lenses | \$115.00 |

Please note:

Fitting fees cover up to two months of follow-up care. Follow-up care is vital to determine the fit of the lens and to protect the health of your eyes. **If you elect to forego the follow-up care and return beyond the initial two-month period, you will be charged a fee of \$40.00.** You must have follow-up care in order to finalize contact lenses, unless otherwise authorized by the doctor.

The price of lenses will vary depending on type and prescription. Some types of contacts are not available in complimentary trials, i.e. gas perms, planned replacement or daily wear soft lenses. These lenses must be purchased before the fitting begins. They may be returned or exchanged as described in the next paragraph. Most soft disposable contacts are available in complimentary trials.

Contacts must be paid for in full when you order your supply. If, within the two-month follow-up period, you feel contacts are not for you, we will credit your account if gas perm contacts are returned in good condition, or if soft lens boxes are not expired and are **unopened**. You may use this credit for other optical purchases for yourself or a family member. **THE FITTING FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED OR CREDITED.** _____(initial)

Fairness to Contact Lens Consumers Act: This act went into effect February 4, 2004. As stated by this Act, you are entitled to a copy of your contact lens prescription once the prescription is finalized by the examining doctor. Receiving a trial lens IS NOT a finalized prescription. A finalized prescription is determined at the follow-up appointment after you have been wearing the trial lenses. **Contact lens prescriptions are valid for one year, per Oklahoma state law.**
